### HONOR ROLL

The Board of Education authorizes the establishment of an Honor Roll to recognize pupils who consistently demonstrate academic excellence. The Honor Roll should recognize both pupils who attain a superior level of achievement and those who consistently maintain an above average level of achievement.

The earning of Honor Roll recognition by a pupil should not be dependent upon the relative degree of difficulty of the program undertaken by the pupil. All courses receiving grades should be included in the system of computation used to award such recognition, and all should be weighted equally. Also, provision should be made to consider the pupil's efforts prior to his or her being awarded Honor Roll recognition.

The Board authorizes the issuance of a Honors Diploma to be awarded to pupils who consistently maintain an acceptable level of academic excellence throughout their high school career.

The Board also authorizes the Superintendent to develop other suitable methods of granting recognition to pupils who maintain an acceptable level of academic achievement.
