ENTRANCE AGE

Admission of children to any grades in the High Point Regional High School shall involve a consideration of chronological age, academic achievement and the emotional and psychological readiness of the children to do the work of those grades determined by the principal upon the recommendation, where applicable, of the child study team.

In a situation where a student seeks admission to the ninth grade at High Point Regional High School, without completing an eighth grade program of studies, admission consideration will be based upon chronological age, academic achievement, and the emotional and psychological readiness to attend high school. Admission decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis. The Superintendent will recommend admission to the Board of Education, if warranted.
