Grades 4 to 9

July 6-10- Crime Scene Investigators!

Experiment with field and laboratory techniques used in actual crime scene investigations! Students will participate with hands-on experiences needed to conduct exciting laboratory procedures such as: hair analysis, document analysis, fabric analysis, blood typing, and fingerprint analysis. The week will culminate in a “who-dunnit” crime scene extravaganza! Field Trip: Swimming and BBQ at HP State Park. \$160

July 13-17 - Rocketry!

Construct your own high flying model rocket and invite your parents to watch it soar on launch day (Friday). Work with others to build rockets that carry eggs, take pictures, and measure altitude. Turn ordinary paper and cardboard into air powered rockets and win prizes in an accuracy launch competition. Finish the week with a sampling of other flying creations that you’ll take home to enjoy over and over. Field Trip: Swimming and BBQ at HP State Park. \$160

July 20-24 - Electrical Madness!

Build a series of exciting electrical devices using commonly available parts and supplies. You’ll learn how to construct balloon popping fuses, electromagnets, electric motors, burglar alarms, and more. Work with our snap circuit kits to create dozens of different projects that chirp, whistle, beep, burble, flash, and buzz! Field Trip: Swimming and BBQ at HP State Park. \$160

July 13-17 - The Amazing Body!

Explore the amazing ways in which the human body works as you go through a typical day in your life. We’ll learn about simple machines, chemistry, and food as fuel. Explore the body systems and how they work together to create the ultimate human body machine. \$150

July 20-24 - Rocketry!

Get a little help to learn some rocketry basics and build your own working model rocket. You’ll cut, glue, sand, and paint your way to a successful launch that your parents will be invited to attend. We’ll explore some basic principles of flight through hands-on activities and a series of demonstrations. Finish the week with a sampling of other flying creations that you’ll take home to enjoy over and over. \$150

Refunds

Wildcat Junior fees have been reduced and we have held Wildcat Discovery tuition fees for 2009 at the same affordable rates. An additional deduction of \$10 per week for sibling enrollment can also be applied.

Refunds or credits will only be issued for cancellations made at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the program (July 6). Cancellations made after that point due to extreme circumstances may result in a credit, but no refunds will be issued.

Extended Care Fees

Wildcat Discovery continues to offer extended care hours!

For parents who need more flexible drop off and pick up times, the following fees apply:

30 minutes before and after care: no additional charge

30 to 90 minutes of before or after care: **\$5 per care session** (payable daily or at the end of each camp week)

A full week of before and after care may be prepaid at the **reduced rate of \$30** (\$20 savings!)

Any child arriving more than 30 minutes early or remaining more than 30 minutes after the end of activities will be subject to the fee schedule described above.
