Dear Student, Parent or Guardian,

High Point Regional High School is excited to offer our students the opportunity to earn college credits through the Concurrent Enrollment Program (CEP). CEP is a partnership between High Point and Sussex County Community College. CEP is a cost-effective and simple way to take college courses without stepping foot on the campus. To qualify, students must be in one or more of the pre-approved classes and must have a minimum of a B average to register. Tuition is \$225 for a 3 credit college course and \$300 for a 4 credit college course.

Below are some highlights of CEP:

- Participation is voluntary
- Students **are not** required to attend SCCC after graduation if they participate in CEP
- Students **can** and **should** take their SCCC transcript with them to the college/university they ultimately attend
- CEP offers high school students the opportunity to earn college credits at a lower cost than full-time college students
- These credits may waive students from required general education courses that colleges/universities require regardless of major
- Students must have a final minimum average of a C or higher to earn credits
