Dear High Point Community:

Today, High Point was notified that a member of our school community has tested positive for COVID-19.

High Point worked with the Sussex County Department of Health to investigate whether members of our school community have had close contact with this individual. In this instance, the individual received a positive test result on Wednesday, November 18. However, the individual has not been on High Point's campus, nor have they participated in any school-sponsored activities, during the current school year.

This case will not impact scheduled activities, nor will any staff or students be directed to quarantine.

High Point appreciates the timely and exhaustive efforts from our local Department of Health, who offers this important reminder:

The symptoms of COVID-19 are similar to the regular seasonal influenza and include fever, coughing, and shortness of breath. Some have reported additional symptoms, such as a runny nose, sore throat, nausea, lethargy, lack of appetite, vomiting, and diarrhea. Individuals who need medical care should call their medical provider to report their illness prior to seeking care at a clinic, physician's office, or hospital. Parents of students exhibiting flu-like symptoms or staff members exhibiting flu-like symptoms are asked to contact a school nurse, local health authorities or the Sussex Department of Health.
