Dear High Point Community:

We have received confirmation by the Sussex County Department of Health that four members of our school community have tested positive for COVID-19.

High Point administration and staff remain in daily communication with the Sussex County Department of Health. Contact tracing has been completed, all parties have been notified, and all necessary and appropriate protocols have been followed. None of the cases will impact future scheduled activities or on-site learning.

High Point appreciates the timely and exhaustive efforts from our local Department of Health, who offers this important reminder:

The symptoms of COVID-19 are similar to the regular seasonal influenza and include fever, coughing, and shortness of breath. Some have reported additional symptoms, such as a runny nose, sore throat, nausea, lethargy, lack of appetite, vomiting, and diarrhea. Individuals who need medical care should call their medical provider to report their illness prior to seeking care at a clinic, physician's office, or hospital. Parents of students exhibiting flu-like symptoms or staff members exhibiting flu-like symptoms are asked to contact a school nurse, local health authorities or the Sussex Department of Health.

We are continuing to monitor this situation and will provide you with updates as appropriate.
