September 2016: High Point Teachers Work Together to Develop Integrated STEM Curriculum

MRS. REBECCA SARNO, MR. ALEXANDER GONZALEZ AND MS. ANN YACCARINO were selected to participate in this summer's STEM Partnership Professional Development at Mercer County Community College. High Point's STEM Program was selected as one of approximately 30 schools statewide to participate in this program, where elements of high quality STEM Programs were explored and teachers were provided the time to collaborate on unit and lesson development that spanned all three disciplines. Mrs. Sarno (Science), Mr. Gonzalez (Tech. Studies), and Ms. Yaccarino (Math) developed a regionally relevant unit that will challenge their students to address the environmental concerns related to transportation, commute times, and traffic flow, issues very much a part of the conversation here in Sussex County. The development of this standards based, multi-disciplinary unit will not only be presented to High Point students, but will be featured as a model unit statewide, representing the power of PLC's and communication between teachers from different departments.
