Dear Parent/Guardian:

Each year students plan their high school program with the help of their parents, teachers, and counselors, for the year ahead. The steps in this process are outlined below:

Step 1: January - Teachers make course recommendations for students. These recommendations are based upon past achievement, test data, and estimates of interest and motivation. Students will only schedule courses for which they have been recommended and meet the necessary pre-requisites.

Step 2: January – The freshman class will have an extended homeroom on January 13th to discuss the scheduling process. All freshmen will schedule their courses for next year during midterm exams during their physical education classes.

February – The sophomore class will have an extended homeroom on February 24th to discuss the scheduling process. They will schedule their courses for next year during the week of February 27th during their English class.

February – The junior class will have an extended homeroom on February 17th to discuss the scheduling process. They will schedule their courses for next year during the week of February 27th during their History class.

Step 3: April/May/June - Students have the opportunity to change course selections by making an appointment with their guidance counselor.

Step 4: July – A tentative schedule will be mailed home.

Step 5: July/August - Students will have the opportunity to change their course selections through ten minute appointments with guidance counselors.

Step 6: September – Final schedules will be distributed on the first day of school. No schedule changes will be allowed except for errors.

****Please note the order in which students are scheduled has no bearing on their opportunity to get courses they selected. Also, teacher recommendations and student course selections will be available online in early February through the Parent Portal of our student information system, Power School. More information on the Parent Portal will follow in the near future.
