- Students’ **academic placements** may be affected by their results on the NJ ASK 8 test. The scores are received in the High Point Guidance office in **August**. Schedule changes may include a level change in English and/or math and possibly the addition of the Innovative Learning Strategies course. When making these changes, we also consider NJ ASK 7 scores, teacher recommendations, and grades received in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- All students who place into Honors English, Honors World Studies, Honors Biology, and CP-A Biology will receive **summer homework**. Assignments will be distributed to you in June.
- You will receive a **summer mailing** from the high school which contains a variety of information such as your bus assignment, free lunch forms, health office packet, and ninth grade physical information. Please note that all freshmen are required to have a physical after their 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation. The main office is staffed throughout the summer. Please feel free to call 973-875-3101 with any questions or concerns.
- The **first day of school for freshmen** is Wednesday, September 5, 2012 (Tentative). This is a half day for freshmen only. You will ride your bus, get locker assignments, run through your entire schedule, and meet your teachers. Peer counselors will be available to assist you throughout the day.
- **Extracurricular and athletic eligibility:** All freshmen are initially eligible to participate in extracurricular activities and athletics. Eligibility is reviewed at the end of the first semester at which time students must have passing averages in classes totaling 30 credits. In order to be eligible in 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades, students must have earned 30 credits in the previous academic year.
- **Athletics:** Students planning on participating in a sport during the *fall, winter, or spring* of their freshman year are eligible for a **free sports physical** provided by our school physician. Check the High Point website for dates and forms. *Fall* athletes must return their completed forms by **AUGUST 1<sup>st</sup>** in order to avoid delays in their athletic eligibility.
