Enrollment in Honors/Advanced Placement courses is restricted to the fulfillment of the following three criteria:

- Grade in progress in corresponding academic area
- Teacher recommendation
- Performance on aptitude test in designated subject area

GPA: High Point Regional High School reports students' weighted grade averages based on the 4.0 scale. Each final grade a student earns is multiplied times a weight factor and credits are applied. The following chart summarizes the weight factors assigned by course difficulty level:

Weight Factor Chart	Level	Factor
	AP	5.15
	Honors	4.95
	CP A	4.50
	CP B	4.15
	CP C	4.05
	General	4.00

Examples: A final grade of 91% in a CP A level class: $.91 \times 4.50 = 4.095$
A final grade of 86% in an AP class: $.86 \times 5.15 = 4.429$

CLASS RANK: Students are ranked according to their weighted grade averages. In order for students to be included in class rank, they must have attended High Point Regional High School for two consecutive years.

Disciplinary Records: The Guidance Department of High Point Regional High School does not include a record of disciplinary action as part of the permanent record of a student.
