5330 Self-Administration of Medication
for Asthma or Severe Allergic Reaction**

As of December 1993, State law permits pupils to self-administer medication for asthma or other potentially life-threatening illnesses in school.

Written authorization for this is required from the physician and from the parent/guardian annually.

! IMPORTANT !

Your child will NOT be permitted to carry his/her inhaler, nebulizer or epinephrine pen unless ALL paperwork is completed in full, including physician and parent signatures. These documents include:

- **Asthma Actions Plan (for asthma only)**
- **Physician Certification for Student to Self-Administer Medication**
- **Parental Permission for Student to Self-Administer Medication**

5338 Diabetes Management

As of January, 2010, State law permits students to self manage/treat his/her diabetes while in school.

Written authorization from both the physician and parent/guardian are required annually.
