- This is a small goal game... **NO GOAL KEEPERS! NO GOAL TENDING!** Goal tending will be called if a CAPTAIN deems a team to be playing against the spirit of the rule. First offense is a team warning. Second offense individual yellow. If there is any subsequent goal tending a yellow card will be awarded and a penalty kick.
- Goals may only be scored from a team's offensive half.
- Sidewalls are out of bounds. If any part of body touches a wall and ball at same time, play is dead it is out of bounds. The ceiling is out of bounds. End walls are out above the GREY horizontal are out of bounds.
