THIS LEAGUE HAS BEEN SET UP FOR THE PLAYERS TO HAVE FUN AND GO HOME HEALTHY. ALL RULES HAVE BEEN DESIGNED TO ACHIEVE THOSE GOALS. IF THERE IS A NEED FOR ANY FURTHER RESTRICTIONS, RULES WILL BE ADDED TO KEEP EVERYONE SAFE. LETS SHOW RESPECT FOR EACH OTHERS GAME, PLAY HARD AND HAVE A BLAST!

## Rules

- ❑ The league coordinators will choose six captains. A draft will take place in mid-December in order to determine team rosters.
- ❑ Rosters will be finalized prior to the first night of the schedule. Rosters will consist of 8 to 9 players. Teams will play 5v5 for 80 minutes. **Non-registered players are not allowed.**
- ❑ **Players must be 25 years of age!** Prior participants and in district residents will take precedence.
- ❑ One registered substitute is allowed from another team of equally ability of the absent player. A sub request will be allowed only if you have 4 players and need a 5<sup>th</sup> to field a team. If a team needs to play with two registered subs they forfeit the game. It shall not be abused to allow players to play for more than one team on a regular basis.
- ❑ This is a small goal game... **NO GOAL KEEPERS! NO GOAL TENDING!** Goal tending will be called if a CAPTAIN deems a team to be playing against the spirit of the rule. First offense is a team warning. Second offense individual yellow. If there is any subsequent goal tending a yellow card will be awarded and a penalty kick. You cannot stand in the paint if you not marking someone.
- ❑ Goals may only be scored from a team's offensive half.
- ❑ Sidewalls are out of bounds. If any part of body touches a wall and ball at same time, play is dead it is out of bounds. The ceiling is out of bounds. End walls are out above the GREY horizontal.
- ❑ Three eighty-minute games for 10 weeks. Eleventh week is a playoff week or make up week.
- ❑ Playoffs 1st place vs. 2nd place, 3rd vs. 4th, 5th vs. 6th
- ❑ Round Robin schedule, play every team twice.
- ❑ All out of bounds balls are restarted as indirect kicks from closest spot where the ball went out.
  - Corner kicks will be awarded if defending team kicks the ball above the GREY horizontal or trap the ball behind the goal.
- ❑ No sliding or going down on floor for tackles (First offense - verbal warning, second offense - yellow card)
- ❑ **Shin guards are mandatory!**
- ❑ Any direct kick foul (including INTENTIONAL handballs) committed within 3-point arc (penalty arc) of basketball court is a penalty kick from center court (Everyone is behind centerline until ball is kicked. Ball is live if missed and player-taking kick cannot touch ball next.)
- ❑ Two yellow cards during the season - miss the next two games. (ANY CAPTAIN CAN ISSUE A CARD)
- ❑ Third yellow card during the season - miss next four games (Extended into the next season if need be).
- ❑ One red card - gone for next four games (Extended into the next season if need be.)
- ❑ Second red card banned from the league for the next three seasons.
- ❑ **No children allowed!**
- ❑ Please help clean up.
- ❑ Only the player being fouled can call the infraction...However, Captains can & will call fouls and rule infractions as they see them. Please respect all calls!
- ❑ The league coordinators reserves the right to deny an application or remove a registered player based upon the programs safety, rule violations, inappropriate behavior and negative interactions with participants. **THINK BEFORE YOU ACT!**
