PROGRAM

ADULT EDUCATION

The High Point Regional Adult School shall be a non-profit organization sponsored by the High Point Regional High School Board of Education. The purpose of this adult school will be to meet the educational, recreational, social and cultural needs of the adult population of the area served by the High Point Regional School District. The Board shall also maintain through the Adult School, a program of instruction in English language and in government and laws for the benefit of foreign-born residents of the district.

In order to support a program of adult education, and education for the foreign born, the Board will utilize school facilities and supplies as required, and provide necessary custodial services.

The program of adult school education shall be maintained at no cost to the Board of Education. Participating students shall be charged tuition pursuant to law and shall provide all supplies necessary to the accomplishment of the program.

The Superintendent is directed to seek out and utilize such federal and state sources of revenue as may be appropriate for the financial support of the adult education program.

All out-of-school youth and adult residents of this district, and presently enrolled students are eligible for attendance in the adult education program, except that such students shall not receive credit toward graduation in the program.
