## Presentation Expectations and Requirements

### To Do Over the Summer:

1. Beginning of the summer read *Think Like a Freak* by Levitt and Dubner
2. Summarize an assigned chapter. (Chapter assignments will be emailed directly to your HP gmail the last week of July)
3. Research a topic that is mentioned in the chapter but not fully developed or a topic that you thought of that connects to the chapter you are summarizing. **Do NOT** just research a topic that has already been thoroughly discussed in the book.
4. Develop a 5-7 minute presentation on your chapter and research topic. You can use Flipgrid, Screencastify, Google Meet, or any other online virtual presentation platform that you feel comfortable working with. If you need help figuring out how to use one of these tools, I can offer assistance and directions.

**Presentations will be submitted and given during the 1st Week of Class. During your presentation you will do the following:**

1. Present your chapter & researched topic to the class.
2. Provide additional materials to class, if necessary.
3. Include visuals in your presentation.
4. After the presentation, lead a Socratic discussion on your chapter. Ask the class questions about related topics or the material that you shared.
5. Provide an authentic transition to the next chapter.
6. Submit a one page synopsis of your presentation, including a reflection, at the end of your presentation. A Google Classroom assignment will be created the first week of class for you to submit this written synopsis.

\*The second week of school, you will be working with a partner(s) to creatively create a presentation for one of the remaining chapters (7-9). Directions for this will be shared at this time.
